1. Commitment to achieving net zero

Indigometrics Limited is committed to achieving net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2045.

This commitment covers emissions from the sources included in Scope 1 and Scope 2 of the Greenhouse Gas Protocol, together with the subset of Scope 3 emissions, namely upstream transportation and distribution, waste generated in operations, business travel, employee commuting, and downstream transportation and distribution.

The commitment applies to the Company's global operations, exceeding the minimum UK geographical boundary required under UK public procurement carbon reporting requirements.

2. Baseline emissions footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases released into the atmosphere before the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. This is the first year in which Indigometrics Limited has measured its emissions, and the 2025 reporting year therefore serves as both the baseline year and the current reporting year.

Emissions are reported in tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent (tCO₂e) covering the seven greenhouse gases of the Kyoto Protocol: carbon dioxide (CO₂), methane (CH₄), nitrous oxide (N₂O), hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs), perfluorocarbons (PFCs), sulphur hexafluoride (SF₆) and nitrogen trifluoride (NF₃). Emissions of gases other than CO₂ arising from the Company's activities are not material.

3. Current emissions reporting

Reporting year: 1 January – 31 December 2025

As 2025 is the first year of measurement, current emissions are identical to the baseline reported at section 2. Total emissions for the reporting year were 8.58 tCO₂e, equivalent to approximately 1.07 tCO₂e per full-time equivalent employee.

Comparative reporting against the baseline will be presented in subsequent annual updates to this plan.

4. Basis of reporting and explanation of nil returns

Indigometrics Limited is a software company providing behavioural analytics services to enterprise clients. It has no owned or leased premises, no company vehicles, no on-site fuel combustion, and no manufacturing, warehousing or physical distribution activity. All personnel work remotely.

The following categories are reported as nil, with explanation as permitted under PPN 006 guidance where a supplier provides an acceptable reason:

- **Scope 1** — the Company owns or controls no vehicles, heating plant, refrigeration or other sources of direct combustion or fugitive emissions.
- **Scope 2** — the Company holds no leased or owned premises and purchases no electricity, heat or steam. Electricity consumed by personnel working from home is reported under Scope 3, employee commuting, in accordance with the GHG Protocol treatment of homeworking.
- **Upstream and downstream transportation and distribution** — the Company supplies software delivered electronically. No goods are transported to or from the Company or on its behalf.
- **Waste generated in operations** — with no premises, the Company generates no operational waste streams. Electronic equipment at end of life is returned for reuse or certified recycling, and quantities are immaterial.

Methodology

Emissions have been calculated in accordance with the GHG Protocol Corporate Standard using the UK Government (DESNZ) greenhouse gas conversion factors for company reporting.

Air travel is calculated from great circle distances between airport pairs with an 8% uplift applied to reflect indirect routing and holding patterns, multiplied by passenger-kilometre conversion factors for economy class including radiative forcing. Homeworking emissions are estimated using an activity-based approach combining an equipment consumption allowance and a heating and cooling allowance per full-time equivalent, converted at the applicable grid electricity factor.

Where primary data was not available, the Company has used documented estimation methods and has stated the assumptions applied. As a small enterprise reporting for the first time, the Company will improve data quality in subsequent reporting years by recording travel bookings and equipment inventories at the point of transaction.

5. Emissions reduction targets

To continue progress towards achieving net zero, Indigometrics Limited has adopted the following targets against the 2025 baseline of 8.58 tCO₂e:

Because the Company expects to grow, absolute targets are supplemented by an intensity target of a 50% reduction in emissions per full-time equivalent employee by 2035 against the 2025 figure of 1.07 tCO₂e per FTE. Net zero is defined as a reduction in absolute emissions of at least 90% against the baseline, with any remaining residual emissions neutralised. The Company will prioritise absolute reduction over neutralisation, and will address residual emissions through certified carbon removals rather than avoidance-based offsetting. The proportion of the target met through neutralisation rather than reduction will be disclosed in each annual update to this plan.

6. Carbon reduction projects and environmental management measures

The following measures are in effect and will be applied by the Company in the performance of public sector contracts:

- Remote-first delivery. Client engagements, including onboarding, briefings, and reporting sessions, are delivered remotely by default. In-person attendance is undertaken only where a client requires it or where remote delivery would materially reduce the quality of the engagement.
- Travel hierarchy. Where travel is necessary, the Company applies a hierarchy of remote attendance first, then rail, then air. Air travel is booked in economy class. Trips are consolidated so that a single journey serves multiple purposes wherever scheduling allows.
- No premises footprint. The Company operates without leased offices, eliminating emissions from building energy, commuting to a fixed site, and associated operational waste.
- Low-carbon cloud infrastructure. The Company selects cloud hosting regions and providers on the basis of published renewable energy matching and carbon intensity, and reviews this selection when infrastructure is provisioned or migrated.
- Equipment lifecycle. Computing equipment is specified for durability and retained in service for a minimum of four years, with repair preferred over replacement and end-of-life devices returned for reuse or certified recycling.
- Supplier engagement. The Company takes the carbon reduction commitments of its suppliers and sub-processors into account when selecting and renewing services, and encourages suppliers to publish their own reduction plans.
- Measurement and review. Emissions are measured annually, this plan is updated annually, and progress against the targets at section 5 is reported publicly.

7. Declaration and sign off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with Procurement Policy Note 006 (PPN 006), the associated guidance, and the Technical Standard for the Completion of Carbon Reduction Plans. It is intended to satisfy the carbon reduction reporting requirements applied by UK public sector contracting authorities, including those bodies that adopt PPN 006 through their own sector guidance.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol Corporate Standard, and use the appropriate UK Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting.

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard.

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been reviewed and approved by the board of directors of Indigometrics Limited. It is published and clearly signposted on the Company's website and will be reviewed and updated at least annually.
